

Flag Quiz

1. What is the correct position of a flag hanging behind a speaker?



It is not proper to display the flag behind a speaker.



The blue field should be at the top and at the observer's left.

2. Where should the American Flag be carried in a procession with another flag?

3. On an east and west road, how should the Flag be flown across the street?

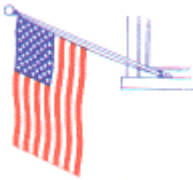
- The flag should never be hung across a street.

4. When should the Flag be displayed?

- The flag should be displayed everyday of the year without regard to any outside reason.

5. How do you properly fold the Flag?

- Never fold the flag. It should be tightly rolled into a tight roll after folding it twice lengthwise.
- Fold the flag in half, then begin folding it into a triangle, starting with the stripes.
- Fold the flag in half lengthwise, and then again lengthwise, then fold end-to-end, to form a perfect square with the stars on top.
- Fold the flag in half lengthwise, and then again lengthwise, keeping the blue field (union) on the outside. Holding the blue field (union), make triangular folds from the opposite end until nothing shows but the blue field (union).

6. What is the proper manner of displaying the Flag on an automobile?

- It may be flown in an upright position from a staff firmly clamped to the chassis or clamped to the right front fender.
- It can be draped over the hood of the automobile as long as the union is up mean the drivers side.
- It can be clamped from a staff clamped in a window.
- Our Flag cannot be legally displayed on any part of an automobile.

7. Can the mayor order the Flag to be half-staffed?
